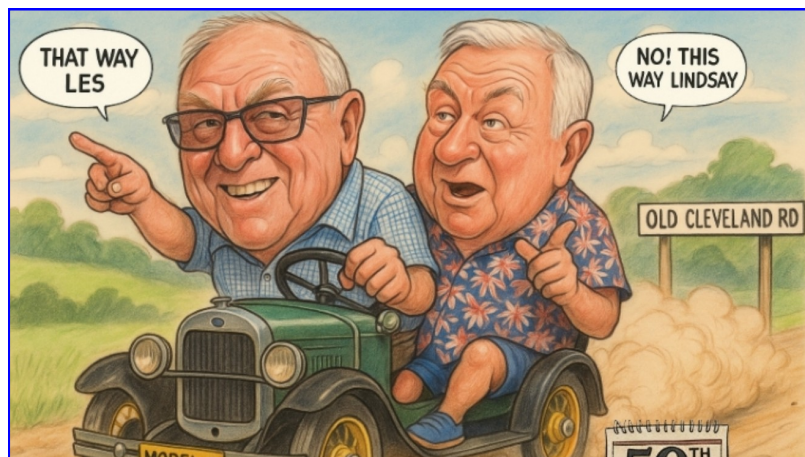

I have wonderful memories a remarkable couple who took us along for the ride through their beloved Fassifern Vally where they met and spent most of their lives. I am sure Ken and Ann have led us on many mysteries runs through countryside where they spent many of their youngest years. Through hidden valleys, creeks crossings and winding roads then pausing at their favourite place in the whole world. Under the giant gum tree that overlooked the family farm. It was their special place on the way home after a dance on a Saturday night and they delighted sharing with us. The old gum, Ken and Ann and old "Beute" their beloved Model A. If only trees could talk. And then there were the longer runs. Across the Nullarbor to Busselton, Darwin and Tasmania to attend a National meet. They loved the adventure and fun of enjoying the open road, but you stop in town for morning tea or lunch and the familiar sight of Ann disappearing into a local op shop was usually a sign that Ken would be warming the bench seat on the footpath outside for a while. Not to disappoint, Ann would emerge with one or both of her favourite items. The unusual nick knacks or a very colourful item of clothing. I remember in Mudgee many years ago, we had a fun night. The men enjoying a quiet beverage with the girls crammed into Ann's motel room just about lifting the roof off. We were due to leave town next day with a 7:30 am start, but Ann and the girls decided one last look at the shops was needed just in case they had missed something. The men spent quite some time warming the bench seats that day and we finally got on the road about 1:30 pm, after lunch. After we lost Ken, Ann took it on herself to continue to show us the wonders of their young lives playground and loved to organise a day run somewhere with morning tea at a hilltop lookout, then at a country pub, and I swear she knew every pub, Vinnies or antique store within 100 km from Ipswich. Then there were the club functions. The Christmas parties where Ann would delight in wearing new and always colourful outfits always arrive with a large tray of something special for the table and so enjoy a yarn and a good laugh. I remember her famous Chocolate squares. She knew they were a favourite of mine and would always make sure I got my share. My lasting memory of Ann is of a lady who loved the company of friends, loved a laugh and dearly loved the man she chose to go on life's journey with. God speed dear Lady, we miss you.

Our 1928-1931 Fords were *NOT* Henry's First Model "A" !

Yep! The first Model A Ford was built by the Ford Motor Company in **1903**, *not* 1928! Let's start with a little history lesson.

In 1895, Henry Ford was working as the chief engineer for the Edison Illuminating Company in Detroit, Michigan. In a small workshop behind his home, he pursued his ambitious hobby to develop a horseless carriage.

On June 4, 1896, with the help of several friends, Henry put the finishing touches on his ethanol powered motor and completed his first automobile which he called a "**Quadricycle**." His Quadricycle, with a two cycle engine producing four horsepower, had only two forward gears and could achieve 20 mph. It had a 3 gallon fuel tank, no brakes, and was tiller steered.

For the next seven years, Henry experimented with other engines and, in **1903**, with the help of some financial backers, established **The Ford Motor Company**.

Their *first* automobile to be produced was the **1903 Model A Ford**. The **1903 Ford Model A** came as a **two seater runabout**, selling for \$800, and as a **four seater tonneau** model for \$900. An optional top was also available for each model. **All were painted red !** The engine had two cylinders, produced 8 hp and could reach a top speed of 28 mph. This Model A had two forward speeds and one reverse, had rear wheel band brakes, and the engine was situated in the middle of the car. Ford made and sold 1,750 of this Model A between 1903 and 1904.

During the years 1903 through 1907, The Ford Motor Company produced the Models A, B, C, F, K, N, R and S. The advancements of each of these led to production of the famous **Model T Ford** in **1908**, which remained in production through **1927**!

In **1928**, our **new Model A's** were born.

Question: Why did Henry's company follow the **Model T** with a car that was *again* named the **Model "A" Ford**? Because, Ford said, it was such a significant departure from the previous Model T. He wanted to "wipe the slate clean" and start anew, returning to the beginning of the alphabet with the new model. —by **Tom Dodd**

Bruce E Mc Pherson's Storey, His Grandfathers Model A

The story begins in 1933. My father is born to a KA steam locomotive engine driver and a church organist. This history I have told before. My Grandfather was a keen Model A man. His first car being a 1928 tourer which was his pride and joy.

My father in 1937 is now 3 and keen to jump out. So, the tourer was traded in on a 1937 Canadian built 1930 55B Tudor. My grandfather did all his own maintenance. The trip home (a distance of 150 miles) is another story in itself with frequent stops with adjustments to timing, distributor, carburetor all diarised. Once home, he went over the top end, lapping valves and a decoke. Even though there was petrol rationing he was entitled to fuel as he was considered an essential worker as a train driver and the car never ran on kerosine or had a gas producer.

Pictured are the tools passed onto me. 2 spark plugs with wire to help remove the head. These were hand-made apparently, remains of a socket set with a home-made wrench handle. It is written in my grandmother's diary he made this while driving the train; using the locomotive's furnace to heat the bolt and bend it. Then I'm assuming countless hours filing, all while in charge of a train on the main trunk line. More interesting is the valve spring compression tool. It is a genuine Model A Ford part. This tool was his pride and joy. It sat on the mantelpiece when not used or lent out, much to the disgust of my grandmother. My first recollection of these tools was when as a boy at age 11 (1974), I was asked to remove the back seat and get the tool bag out. Inside I was to get the clamp. And on a very cold winter's evening I removed the tyre from a rim (thank you Alan Jones for doing this same task for me last year on your driveway); with my grandmother barking orders holding the world's smallest most useless torch; taking the tube inside and under the guidance of my grandmother did a puncture repair. My memory of sand paper and vulcanizing glue are quite vivid, in a small kitchen with a blazing fire, glue fumes and being told not to do the clamp up too tightly. At the time I thought it weird my grandmother dusted the tube with talcum powder, smelt pretty good but as a 11-year-old I thought it very weird. The next day off I went on my bike to the Garage to pump up the tube and see if it had no leaks.

Back to the spring compressor. Over the past few months, I have acquired several motors. Finally deciding on a 28 from Rockyview and a 29 from Beerwah the most suitable to rebuild. I thought it novel to use the valve spring compressor my grandfather used. It's pretty worn but has done the job. I've still got assembly of these motors yet. After that I think I'll retire it to my museum shelf. So, if anyone knows the part number for a valve spring compressor tool, please let me know. I'm proud I still have the car in great order and my grand-fathers' tools.

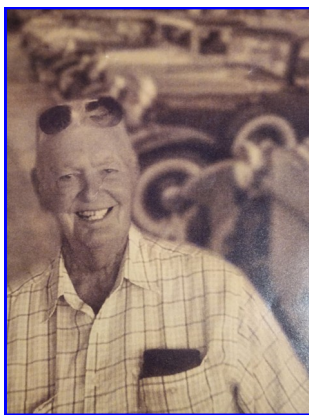
A committee was formed and an annual subscription fee of \$7 was agreed on and our club was up and running.

Sadly the majority of our founding fathers have passed on but over the years many of them have marvelled at where their little club is today and been actively involved in its progress through the years.

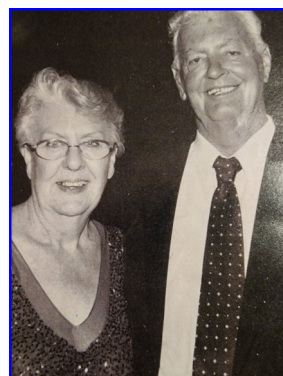

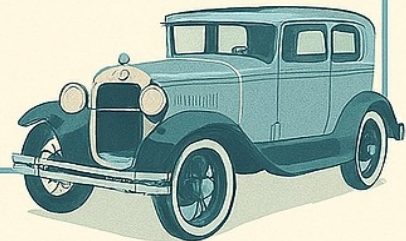
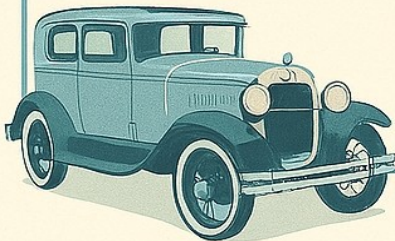


Extension of the 2025 yearly subscription

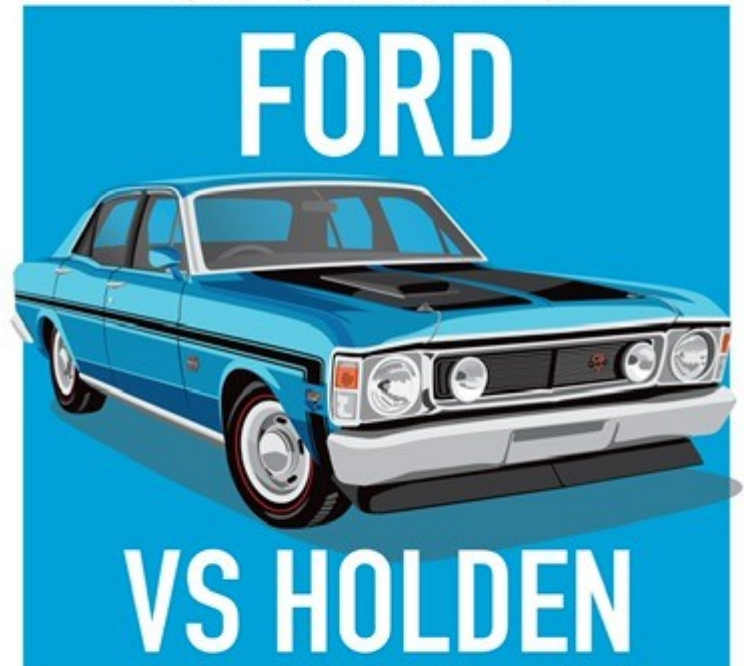
