<u>MAFCA</u> membership dues are \$50.00 per calendar year, which includes a one-year subscription to *The Restorer*.


<u>MARC</u> dues are \$50.00 per calendar year, which includes a one-year subscription to *Model "A" News.* All region members must belong to MARC.
