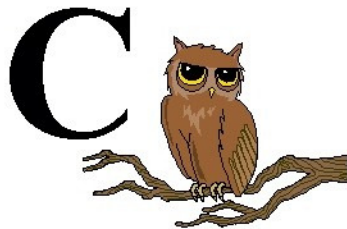

Members brought unwrapped toys that were taken by Kitt and Roger Burrow to the Fire Station for their toy drive.

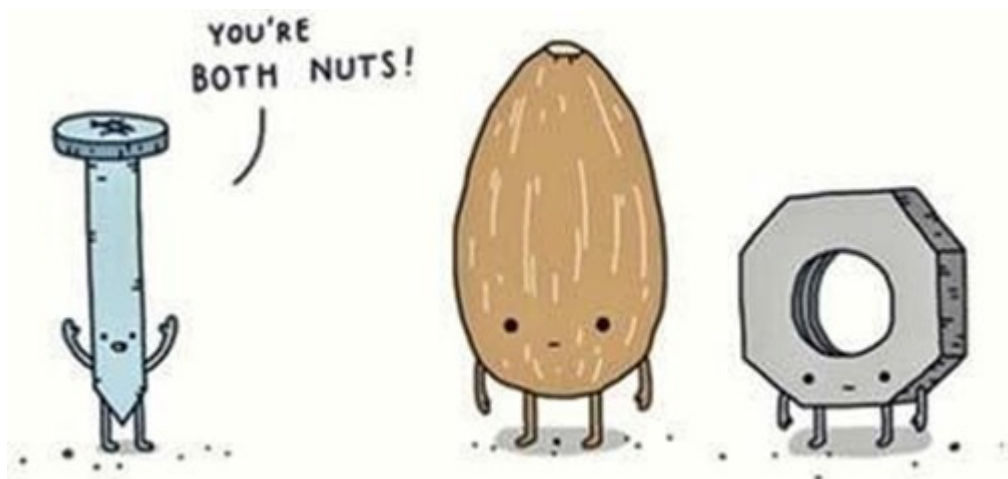
No business was discussed.

Rear Wheel Bearing Lubrication

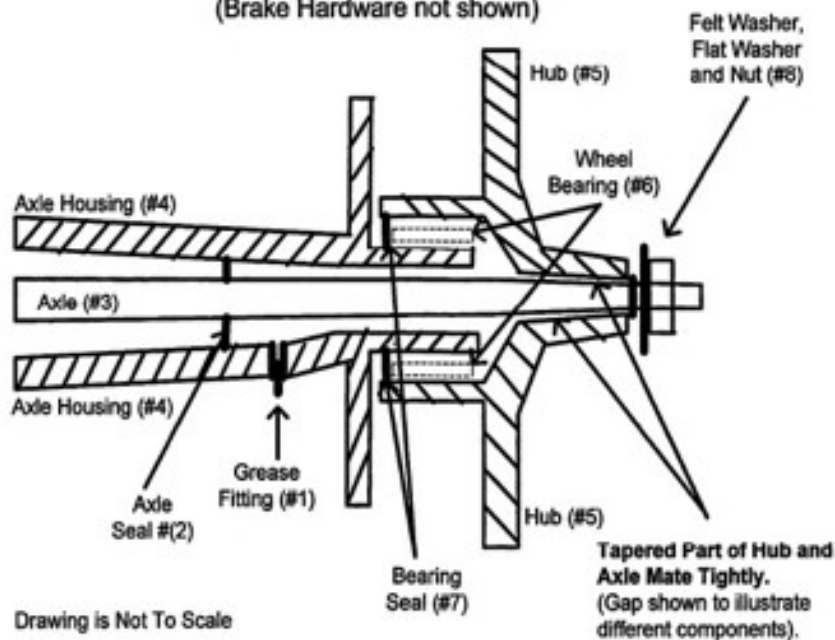
A club member recently ask me if I could to explain the how the Model A rear wheel bearings are lubricated, and after some thought, I wasn't sure. I had thought there was a path from the fitting to the bearing race, but realized that wasn't the case.

I did some research, and it is really a little more complicated. There is a U-Tube video published by the Oakleaf A's (Link: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QuDGO2jByac>) that has a diagram of how the grease travels from the fitting to the bearing, and there is also a Tom Endy Technical Article on the Santa Anita A's web-site (Link: <http://www.santaanitas.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/08/Grease-Fittings.pdf>) that address the lubrication of the rear wheel bearing lubrication. The following description is from their published information.

The Rear Axle Lubrication Process will reference the numbered items on the "Rear Axle Cut-Away Diagram" to help understand the lubrication process.

Rear Axle Bearing Lubrication Process: The grease enters the rear axle housing from the grease fitting (#1), fills the cavity around the axle, and is prevented from going into the differential area by the axle seal (#2). The grease then flows outward in the clearance between the axle (#3) and the axle housing (#4) and then into hub (#5), but is prevented from going further by the mating of the hub to the axle where the axle tapers. There may be slight leakage around the key way, but that will be sealed by the felt and flat washer at the axle nut (#8). The grease will then flow into the wheel bearing area, providing lubrication for the bearing (#6). The bearing seal (#7) prevents the grease from entering the backing plate/brake hardware area.
