

Q: Rivet jacks. Mikes Afordable left me a message that they are obsolete and not available despite their website having them. I have a front cross member to re-rivet. Any suggestions? I'm open at this point.

Chads Millwork

A: I had to replace my front cross member because somewhere along the line mine was welded solid. So I cut the old out and found a correct replacement and riveted it in. I ordered the correct replacement rivets and made a backing plate out of a 3/4 bolt with nuts. I then inserted the rivet from inside the frame adjusted the bolt and heated the rivet and used an air hammer. You wedge the bolt between the rivet and the bottom frame rail.

A: Try here. Big Flats Rivet used to be the place to go but they retired. Think this place took their place.


